Greetings, NES Families!

We still believe Spring is coming and hope you do, too! We're looking forward to long afternoons playing outside under the sun, in the woods, and in the gardens of the school. We will be outside most days during Session 5. Fresh air makes for happy, healthy kids. Please ensure that your child is sent to school each day with an extra set of clothing. *As masks have become a necessity, please be sure to pack extras to ensure students are comfortable throughout the school day and during program time.*

Bridges Afterschool offers a safe, fun, and stimulating afterschool experience. We are educators who believe in building great relationships with and among the students; helping students to recognize and realize their potential; and giving kids the opportunity to express themselves in a variety of interesting and enriching activities.

Session 5 begins on **Monday, April 26, and ends on Friday, June 11. Please be aware that there is no Bridges program the last week of school. Due to Memorial Day, there will be no Bridges program offered on May 31st.**

To enroll in the Afterschool program, this ENTIRE Enrollment Form must be filled out and returned by Wednesday, April 14, 2021, to your child's homeroom teacher or email to jbhardy@cvsu.org. If you have not registered with Bridges yet this school year, you also need to complete a Registration Form, Family Guidebook, Fee Determination Form, and Transportation Form. Please acquire these documents from the main office or access them via our website (www.cvsu.org/domain/131). Registration documents must be submitted by the first day of Session 5 in order for your child to participate. If you have not submitted payment for your child's previous participation, that payment or a payment plan is required prior to their start of this next Session.

If registration materials have not been completed in their entirety, they will not be considered for enrollment. Please be aware that programs fill quickly and there are limited spaces available in each activity. Activities will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis or a random-selection lottery system when programs fill by 9 a.m. the day following form distribution. Please expect enrollment confirmation by Friday, April 16.

Bridges will also offer a Summer program July 5th - August 6th. There will be half-day and full-day options from 8:00 am - 5:00 pm. Our program is open to students going into 1st grade through students going into 5th grade. We hope our current 5th grade students will attend the Bridges Middle School program that has plenty of fun and excitement planned. Full details will be included in Summer Program enrollment paperwork scheduled for release in May. Stay Tuned!
