Dear NES and RVS Families,

We are thrilled to be able to offer our full summer program this year! The world isn't "normal" just yet, but it is a dramatic improvement over our situation of a year ago!

I want to make sure you are aware of a few things as you register and enroll your child(ren) in our summer program:

- July 1, 2021, starts our new fiscal and registration year. **All students must have a new registration form.**
- **Our programs fill very quickly.** Enrollment is first-come, first-served.
- **NES students who receive(d) a letter from Principal Russell indicating their eligibility for summer intervention should be sure to enroll in our morning sessions.** These students will be directed to the appropriate classes.
- **There is no cost for the summer intervention program for eligible students.**
- Our transportation surveys indicated that our families do not rely on bus transportation to access our programs. **We will therefore not be offering bus transportation.** If your child cannot attend the program because of lack of transportation, please call me.
- **Students may not arrive at NES before 8:00 a.m.** There will be no adult supervision until 8:00 a.m.
- **8:00 to 8:30 a.m. and 3:00 to 5:00 p.m. are Early Care and After Care hours. This service is an additional cost.** Please see the Fee Determination Form, and let me know if you have any questions.
- **We will continue to follow the COVID-19 safety protocols of the State and CVSU.** These regulations will almost certainly include continuing to wear masks and physical distancing.

Dear NES and RVS Families,

Summer is almost here and you're probably already thinking about ways to keep your kids happy all summer. We hope you will consider allowing them to join us for learning activities and outdoor fun. This year's theme is the Wonderful World of Animals, and each week we will focus on a different group. **Students who will be entering FIRST through FIFTH grades in the fall of 2021 are eligible to participate in the Bridges elementary summer program.** (Students who will be entering sixth through ninth grade will need to complete a middle school enrollment form). We provide breakfast and lunch to all students enrolled in the summer program, or students may bring their own lunch. We will also offer early care from 8:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and late care from 3:00 to 5:00 for an additional fee.

The core of our summer program is the morning session where students will spend time in a class determined by grade. Morning session is led by licensed teachers and based on a weekly theme. Students will engage in fun, interactive lessons, both indoors and out, designed to prevent summer learning-loss and improve math and literacy skills. Whether constructing waterways in the splash area, building forts in the woods, or making a book in the classroom, students will have the opportunity to learn through fun and engaging projects.

Afternoon activities are spent in mixed-grade groups and offer students the opportunity to further explore the weekly theme through a hands-on project. Students will pick one of the activities to focus on for the week. They might hike in the school forest, experiment with a new art form, or make the biggest paper airplane in school history. This is the time we let students' imaginations guide their learning.

For enrollment in the CVSU Afterschool Summer Program, please complete both sides of this form and submit to Jenny Bartlett-Hardy the Bridges office at NES via email at jbhardy@cvsu.org or have your child return it to their school day teacher to be accepted. Space is limited and activities are filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

In order for your child to participate, you will need to submit a completed **registration form, transportation form, and fee determination form prior to the start of summer program.** they can also be completed via Google Forms accessed from the CVSU Afterschool webpage at <https://www.cvsu.org/domain/131>

Marvelous Mammals will explore the similarities and differences between mammals and other animals. Mammals are the most adaptable animal on the planet. What traits make mammals a mammal? Are all mammals land creatures? You will find out the answers to these questions and more in Week 2.



WEEK 3: Awesome Amphibians

July 19-July 23

Awesome Amphibians will take you down the slippery slope of distinguishing these creatures from other water-loving animals. What are the 5 types of amphibians? What is the strangest amphibian? What were the first amphibians on Earth? If you are curious about these creatures, join us for Week 3.



WEEK 4: Radical Reptiles

July 26 - July 30

Slithery, scaly Radical Reptiles are air-breathing vertebrates covered in special skin. How long ago did reptiles evolve? What are the major types of living reptiles? What is the biggest reptile? Come hang out with us for Week 4 to find out more.



WEEK 5: Fish Frenzy

August 2-August 6

Let's look outside the fishbowl in Fish Frenzy. Do these gill-bearing vertebrates ever sleep? There are over 300,000 different species of fish. Jellyfish, Starfish and Crayfish are not even fish! Fish are cold-blooded like reptiles and amphibians. Come take a swim in our "aquarium" and learn more in Week 5.
